Taking this into consideration, our Northwest Arkansas office implemented both a Superintendent Development Program, and in conjunction with the South Central operation, a Carpentry Apprenticeship Program. This continues a long tradition of in-house education dating back to when the company founded Nabholz University in 1973.



We've improved the package we offer our craftspeople by expanding their vacation benefits. These initiatives help address the growing skills gap and labor shortage. By maintaining our reputation as a company that invests in its employees, we will retain and recruit the best craftspeople.

Nabholz continues to invest in its employees by doing everything we can to achieve our goal of completing a year with zero incidents. We're happy to report that 17 of our operation groups were incident free in 2015! Nabholz achieved an incident rate 71% below industry average, but we're still focused on improving. As we move forward in 2016, we will continue to find ways to better our safety record, as it is our duty to assure everyone goes home safely to their families at the end of each day.

With an eye on improving services for our clients, we added several new faces to the Nabholz team. Cassie Reese serves as VP of Client Relations in Oklahoma. Chris Wright was hired as Director of Virtual Design, this position will serve all locations by implementing new, strategic preconstruction practices throughout the company.

On top of all that, we've made roadways safer, installed a massive and priceless work of art, removed asbestos and mold, and preserved historic buildings. These are just a few of the many ways we've served our clients with quality and integrity, building our communities project by project.

This year, we implemented a new customer satisfaction tool to better enable clients to communicate how we're doing and measure in a quantifiable way how well we are meeting their expectations. The response was overwhelmingly positive. Our Net Promoter Score (NPS) is 84, a significantly higher score than some of the most trusted names in business. However, the feedback we get from customers goes far beyond






Financial Growth

We saw our highest revenues ever in 2015 - \$550.5 million, a 31% increase from 2014. In 2015, Nabholz teams performed over 6,000 projects in 30 states, ranging from \$100 service calls to multi-million dollar contracts.

Much of this growth can be attributed to a 36% increase in revenue by our construction group. Other key factors were 47% and 33% increases in revenue by our Civil and Environmental groups, respectively. Industrial and specialty services revenue remained strong and steady, with little change from 2014.



Substantial growth in significant market sectors also contributed to increased revenues in 2015. Most saw considerable gains in revenue from 2014, including Healthcare (+41%) and Higher Education (+54%). Others, like Telecom, stayed flat and only one key market, Industrial & Manufacturing, decreased but still carries 6% of the company's overall revenues. Serving a diverse group of clients in a range of market sectors continues to be an asset for Nabholz, facilitating safe, sustainable growth.

Revenues for our Industrial Services group remain strong. We maintained strength in our core geographic markets, and saw positive growth in our Memphis location, which serves clients in the eastern Tennessee and northern Mississippi markets. Our Rogers team added an impressive new OmaxMAXIEM JetMachining Center, which uses a high-pressure stream of water to cut metal, glass, plastic, and stone. This new addition means we can deliver more products with increased quality and faster turnaround times for our clients.

2015 was a banner year for our Industrial Services group in terms of safety. All three Industrial teams–Rogers, Little Rock, and Memphis– remained accident free for the entire year, with our Rogers team celebrating two years of accident-free work. Our skilled craftsmen proved that they can deliver quality, on-time work without sacrificing high safety standards. We applaud their commitment to live by the Nabholz safety promise on every task, every time.

Nabholz' Civil group continues to exceed company and client expectations. The group is a leader in both revenue growth and safety. Revenues increased 47% in 2015 and the team completed two years without a single recordable or lost-time incident, during which they logged over 450,000 man-hours.

Our Civil group continues to earn projects and achieve a good mix of work in site preparation, excavation, and road construction. Nabholz' Civil team has built a reputation as a dependable, high-quality subcontractor, often supplying site work for other large contractors, as well as our own Construction group, on projects like the new Walmart Neighborhood Market in Rogers, AR.

In July, our team completed a \$6 million upgrade and expansion to the City of Tulsa's Cherry Creek flow equalization basin.

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Our crew provided sitework on many projects this year, including the Walmart Neighborhood Market in Rogers, Arkansas.

Our team completed a \$23 million, 6-mile improvement of Highway 62 in Northwest Arkansas. Improvements included two new miles of five-lane highway, four miles of widening of existing highway, and a new 256-foot bridge. The team logged over 65,000 man-hours of accident-free work to complete this project 21 days ahead of schedule.

ENVIRONMENTAL

Environmental assessments, consulting, asbestos abatement, mold remediation

In 2015, Nabholz Environmental Services saw a 33% increase in revenue from 2014. The team completed 66 projects in fiscal year 2015, 22 of which were projects for schools and universities. These schools, along with churches, municipalities, and federal government agencies, comprised the diverse group of clients that turned to Environmental Services to tackle their unique challenges.

The team performed multiple projects of note in 2015. For one elementary school, the team completed asbestos abatement of 54,000 square feet of floor tile and mastic in just twelve days. The group also performed emergency work, including asbestos abatement of a boiler and piping for a homeless shelter over the Christmas holiday. The group provided comprehensive environmental consulting services for the City of Conway's new airport construction project: first identifying contaminants at the site, then performing mold remediation and asbestos abatement, removal and disposal of contaminated soil, post-remediation verification sampling, and removal of an underground storage tank, which our team located by examining historical and aerial photography.

We also provided environmental assessment services, establishing our reputation as an experienced resource and partner in complying with regulations. We provided four different school districts their AHERA three-year reinspections, and performed numerous indoor air quality (IAQ) assessments for clients.

Hurricane

The crew performed asbestos abatement of 54,000-square-feet of floor tile and mastic in this elementary school, completing the job in just 12 days.

Our team performed asbestos abatement on 42,000-square-feet of floor tile and 30,000-squarefeet of roofing on this elementary school. We also removed asbestos pipe fittings and windows where the putty contained asbestos.

SPECIALTY SERVICES

Emergency repairs, renovations, facility maintenance, demolitions, fleet equipment services, concrete, and more

From small finish-out jobs to complete remodels, the projects completed by our Specialty Services group ran the gamut in 2015. Our Fort Smith team employed a helicopter to serve our client, Rheem, in the most efficient manner. In Little Rock, our skilled craftsmen transformed the inside of an old filling station into a beautiful, usable display and meeting space. Our Springfield team turned a 156-year-old barn—disassembled and moved from Canada—into a modern-day welcome center in Branson, MO in just 29 days. Most importantly, all of our Specialty Services teams were there for our clients in emergency situations when they needed high-quality repair service in a hurry.

Revenue from our Specialty Services group as a whole held steady, with little change from the 2014 returns. The Kansas City and Springfield markets remain strong, as both saw increased revenues for 2015. New leadership puts Specialty Services in position for a strong 2016; Paul Jones assumed the role of manager for our Memphis office, Austin Kyzer returned to Central Arkansas to manage the Conway team, Rodney Ward stepped up as

Nabholz Specialty Services continues to exceed customer expectations, ensuring customer satisfaction after the sale and surprising new clients with the range of services offered. For Rheem Manufacturing, our team employed a helicopter to place rooftop air handling units.

Our Millwork group saw revenues increase 66% from 2014. In 2015, the group focused on efficiency, incorporating Lean practices into their job processes. Our skilled cabinet makers and installers provided their trademark high-quality work on a variety of projects, including University of Arkansas' Champions Hall, in which they built and installed trim work, wall paneling, and millwork. At the Scott Family AMAZEUM, the team's precise trim work, wall panels, case work, and receptionist desk added to the museum's whimsical look. We expect the group to continue its strong performance under new manager Jonathan Davis, a past Nabholz Project Engineer and Superintendent.

CURIOSITY CORNER

Our crew provided a wide variety of custom woodwork, including wall panels, mobile greeters' desks, custom millwork, and multi-colored stained cabinets for the Kids Art Room of the Scott Family AMAZEUM.



On the Champions Hall project, our team installed a mesquite feature wall. These pre-finished panels were installed using a tongue and groove system, and their varying thicknesses give the wall a three-dimensional effect.



CRANE & EQUIPMENT RENTAL

This year we added key pieces to our fleet, expanding the variety of equipment we offer our clients.

We purchased a National Crane 40-ton Boom Truck, which features a 142-foot powered boom and 197-foot total reach. We also added a Terex 80-ton Telescopic Crane to our fleet in Northwest Arkansas.

The safety of our employees and clients remains the top priority. We spend a tremendous amount of time and training to ensure that our fleet is maintained and operated with the highest safety standards. All crane operators are NCCCO certified, the highest recognizable industry standard for crane safety.
